## Chamber launches new Marketplace to enhance summer event line-up

The East Troy Area Chamber of Commerce will coordinate weekly events on the historic village square from May 22 through Sept. 25.

East Troy Marketplace will take place on Saturdays from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., except during the Woman's Club Arts & Crafts Fair on June 12 and the East Troy Bluegrass Festival on Sept. 11.

This new initiative, called Experience Historic East Troy, brings together the Chamber, the East Troy Electric Railroad, the East Troy Area Historical Society and the Village of East Troy's Economic Development Committee to create business opportunities, attractions and enhance experiences for residents and visitors to the East Troy community.

The Chamber will coordinate Marketplace booths for the sale of local farm and horticultural products, locally produced specialty foods, local arts and handicrafts and other local sales and services. Merchandise or presentations reminiscent of 100 years ago are encouraged, with further opportunities available for vendors to demonstrate the production of their historically relevant merchandise.

Booths will be available for \$15 per week or \$150 for the season for Chamber members and \$25 per week or \$250 for the season for non-members. Special membership rates will be available to vendors.

During the Marketplace hours, East Troy Ambassadors will lead people from the railroad (expected to attract 20,000 visitors this season) to and from the square. The historical society's new museum will be open and staffed with knowledgeable volunteers. The retail businesses around the square will be encouraged to offer specials. Other attractions will be scheduled on the square weekly, such as historic displays and presentations, musical entertainment, walking tours and more. ### Kubicki Museum and Heritage Center

The East Troy Area Historical Society will open the Kubicki Museum and Heritage Center at 2106 Church Street on May 22. The museum and heritage center provides a showcase of local history in which the public is invited to view artifacts, books, maps, documents, photographs and other historical material in the ETAHS collection.

The materials exhibited will deal with this history of the Village of East Troy, Town of Troy, Town of East Troy, Town of Spring Prairie and Town of La Fayette as well as Walworth County, the state of Wisconsin and the United States. Special themed exhibits will be on display in the museum from time to time beginning May 22.

The public will also be invited to do historical and genealogical research at the museum and heritage center with the help of the ETAHS all-volunteer staff.

Hours and days of operation are Wednesdays from 9 a.m. – noon, Saturday and Sunday from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. and days of special events held on and around the square in and around the Village of East Troy.

The ETAHS will also hold monthly membership meetings at the museum at 7 p.m. the second Tuesday of each month. Special meetings and programs open to the public will also be scheduled.

## Chamber Sparks Positive Energy With 2010 Events

The East Troy Area Chamber of Commerce Ambassador Committee, led by Pam Burki of Realty Executives Integrity, set the tone for our 2010 events. East Troy Expo 2010, presented on March 20 at East Troy Middle School, overflowed with positive energy.

Vendors and attendees alike contributed to the good vibes that were created by the exchange of useful information, great conversations, interesting demonstrations, terrific entertainment, tasty food and, of course, lots of free stuff. The new health fair seemed to add a new dimension to the event, offering a showcase for this growing sector of our local business community.

Vendor surveys showed high satisfaction with the experience at this year's Expo, with enthusiasm expressed for participation in next year's event – tentatively set for Saturday, March 19, 2011.

This committee has representation from the Chamber, the East Troy Electric Railroad, the East Troy Area Historical Society and the Village of East Troy's Economic Development Committee.
